Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-22 educational progress for Forest Area Middle/High School. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given a label.

Forest Area Middle/High School continues to focus on student growth. Our primary goal is for all students to reach grade level in all content areas. We have undergone curriculum alignments for all content areas including Social Emotional Learning. Our school is also a trauma informed school focusing on restorative practices to improve the behaviors of our students.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

#### PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

School attendance boundaries are set by the Board of Education. All students living in the attendance area of a school attend that school unless the Schools of Choice option is selected.

#### THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Forest Area Middle/High School is in compliance with the Michigan guidelines for school improvement. In 2020 – 2021, Forest Area MS/HS started development of the Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP). A few of our focus areas for were: Improving Student Supports, improving our Instructional Infrastructure, and becoming a trauma informed district. We currently have a leadership team in place to oversee the implementation and follow through of district initiatives. We will continuously monitor our implementation efforts based on data and adjust as needed.
